ON JANUARY 17, 2025, AT APPROXIMATELY 1230 HOURS, I WAS CONTACTED BY DETECTIVE SERGEANT R. MURPHY #9213 AND DIRECTED TO RESPOND TO 7300 SOUTH 35TH AVENUE REFERENCE AN OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING INVESTIGATION. UPON ARRIVAL AT 1300 HOURS, I NOTED THE AREA WAS CORDONED OFF WITH YELLOW CRIME SCENE TAPE AND UNIFORMED OFFICERS WERE PROVIDING SECURITY AND PREVENTING UNAUTHORIZED PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FROM ENTERING THE SCENE.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1400 HOURS, I ATTENDED A BRIEFING CONDUCTED BY SERGEANT MURPHY AND LEARNED THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF THIS INCIDENT.

ON JANUARY 17, 2025, AT APPROXIMATELY 1040 HOURS, THE 80X COMMUNITY ACTION SQUAD WAS TAKING ENFORCEMENT ACTION AT A VACANT HOUSE AT CONTACT WITH INDIVIDUALS AT THE HOUSE. MULTIPLE SUBJECTS WERE OBSERVED EXITING THE HOUSE AND JUMPING THE BACK WALL.

THE OFFICERS WENT TO BASELINE ROAD AND ATTEMPTED TO CONTACT ONE OF THE INDIVIDUALS OBSERVED FLEEING THE HOUSE. THE SUBJECT PULLED OUT A HANDGUN AND RAN WESTBOUND ON BASELINE ROAD. THE SUBJECT RAN TO 35TH AVENUE AND TURNED NORTH ONTO 35TH AVENUE. OFFICERS RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO #10038 AND AGUILAR #9607 FOLLOWED THE SUBJECT IN THEIR MARKED POLICE TAHOE.

WHEN THEY REACHED THE ENTRANCE TO THE GATED COMMUNITY AT 3500 WEST PARK STREET, THE SUBJECT POINTED A HANDGUN AT THE TWO OFFICERS. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO THEN FIRED ONE ROUND AT THE SUBJECT FROM THE OPEN FRONT PASSENGER WINDOW OF THE TAHOE. THE SUBJECT IMMEDIATELY FELL TO THE GROUND.

THE SUBJECT, LATER IDENTIFIED AS CHRISTOPHER PHILLIPS, WAS TRANSPORTED TO BANNER UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER AT 1111 EAST MCDOWELL ROAD. HE WAS LATER PRONOUNCED DECEASED AT 1149 HOURS.

A BLACK SMITH & WESSON HANDGUN WAS OBSERVED ON THE GROUND NEAR CHRISTOPHER WHEN HE WAS HANDCUFFED. THE HANDGUN WAS REPORTED STOLEN FROM A 2023 PHOENIX BURGLARY FROM VEHICLE INCIDENT. CHRISTOPHER WAS ALSO A PROHIBITED POSSESSOR.

AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE BRIEFING, I WAS ASSIGNED AS THE CASE AGENT REFERENCE THIS INVESTIGATION.

*** SUMMARY ***

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO CONDUCTED A WALK-THROUGH INTERVIEW AT THE SCENE. FOR DETAILS REGARDING HIS INTERVIEW, SEE THE SEPARATE INTERVIEW SUPPLEMENT.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO WAS THE PASSENGER IN THE MARKED TAHOE FOLLOWING THE SUBJECT IN RED THAT RAN FROM HIM AND OFFICER AGUILAR ON BASELINE ROAD. HE OBSERVED THE MALE PULL A HANDGUN FROM HIS PANTS AND RUN AWAY FROM THEM ON BASELINE ROAD.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO RETRIEVED HIS PATROL RIFLE AND RODE IN THE PASSENGER SEAT OF THE TAHOE. WHEN THEY REACHED 35TH AVENUE AND PARK STREET, OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO OBSERVED THE MALE IN RED POINT THE BLACK HANDGUN TOWARD HIM AND OFFICER AGUILAR. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO FEARED FOR HIS SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OFFICER AGUILAR AND FIRED AT THE MALE IN RED ONCE FROM HIS



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PATROL RIFLE.

THE MALE FELL TO THE GROUND AND WAS LATER DETAINED AND HANDCUFFED. ADDITIONAL OFFICERS ARRIVED ON SCENE AND TREATED THE MALE SUBJECT UNTIL THE PHOENIX FIRE DEPARTMENT ARRIVED ON SCENE AND TRANSPORTED HIM TO BANNER UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER.

OFFICER AGUILAR CONDUCTED A WALK-THROUGH INTERVIEW AT THE SCENE. FOR DETAILS REGARDING HIS INTERVIEW, SEE THE SEPARATE INTERVIEW SUPPLEMENT.

OFFICER AGUILAR OBSERVED TWO MEN JUMP THE WALL BEHIND A HOUSE. ONE WORE A READ SWEATER. THE OFFICERS WENT TO BASELINE ROAD AND OFFICER AGUILAR OBSERVED THE SAME SUBJECT ON THE SOUTHSIDE OF BASELINE ATTEMPTING TO HIDE FROM THEM. WHEN THEY ATTEMPTED TO CONTACT THE MALE, HE RAN WESTBOUND. OFFICER AGUILAR ATTEMPTED TO CHASE THE MALE ON FOOT AND OBSERVED HIM PULL A BLACK HANDGUN FROM HIS WAISTBAND AREA.

THE TWO OFFICERS FOLLOWED THE MALE IN THE RED SWEATER WESTBOUND ON BASELINE AND THEN NORTH ON 35TH AVENUE. WHEN THEY REACHED 35TH AVENUE AND PARK STREET THE MALE IN THE RED SWEATER TURNED TO RUN INTO THE GATED COMMUNITY. AS HE TURNED, THE MALE TURNED HIS UPPER BODY BACK TOWARD THE TWO OFFICERS IN THE MARKED TAHOE AND POINTED HIS HANDGUN AT THEM.

OFFICER AGUILAR WAS AFRAID THE MALE WAS GOING TO SHOOT AT THEM AND INSTINCTIVELY LOWERED HIMSELF IN THE SEAT AND STOPPED THE TAHOE IN THE STREET. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO FIRED ONE ROUND FROM HIS PATROL RIFLE MOMENTS AFTER THE MALE IN THE RED SWEATER POINTED THE HANDGUN AT THEM.

THE MALE SUSPECT WAS IDENTIFIED BY FINGERPRINTS AS CHRISTOPHER PHILLIPS. CHRISTOPHER WAS PRONOUNCED DECEASED BY DOCTOR CRIGGER AT BANNER UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER.

THE SCENE WAS SECURED BY UNIFORMED OFFICERS AND CRIME SCENE TAPE. UPON THE ARRIVAL OF THE REST OF THE INVESTIGATIVE TEAM, WE WERE GIVEN A BRIEFING BY SERGEANT MURPHY, WHO PROVIDED WHAT INFORMATION WAS KNOWN TO THAT POINT. PLEASE SEE DETECTIVE J. JOHNSON'S #6998 REPORT FOR DETAILS OF THE BRIEFING.

AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE BRIEFING, I WAS ASSIGNED TO CONDUCT THE SCENE PORTION OF THE INVESTIGATION WITH CRIME SCENE SPECIALIST (CSS) D. LUCAS AND CSS B. RANEY.

SCENE INVESTIGATION:

THE SCENE INVESTIGATION BEGAN AT ABOUT 1450 HOURS WHEN CSS RANEY BEGAN DOCUMENTING THE SCENE

WITH DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS.

THE SCENE WAS LOCATED OUTDOORS IN THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH 35TH AVENUE AND WEST PARK STREET WHICH WAS A GATED AUTOMOBILE ENTRANCE TO THE SANTOLINA NEIGHBORHOOD. THE SANTOLINA NEIGHBORHOOD WAS SURROUNDED BY BLOCK WALLS, METAL FENCING, AND METAL GATES AT ROADWAYS AND SIDEWALK ENTRANCES. A PEDESTRIAN GATE WAS LOCATED SOUTH OF THE AUTOMOBILE GATE ON WEST PARK STREET. THERE WERE "NO TRESPASSING" SIGNS LOCATED ON THE PEDESTRIAN GATE, ON THE BOULEVARD AT THE AUTOMOBILE GATE ENTRANCE, AND ON THE BLOCK WALL AT THE SOUTH EAST CORNER OF THE SCENE.

THERE WERE MULTIPLE CAMERAS AT THE VEHICLE GATE ENTRANCE. A REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE RESPONSIBLE COMPANY RESPONDED DURING THE INVESTIGATION AND IT WAS FOUND THAT ANY CAMERA THAT WOULD HAVE HAD AN ANGLE TOWARD THE SCENE WAS NOT WORKING. THE OTHER CAMERAS WERE POINTED IN A DIRECTION THAT WOULD NOT HAVE CAPTURED THE INCIDENT.



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INITIAL SCENE PHOTOGRAPHS WERE TAKEN WITH MARKED PATROL TAHOE 111727 PARKED ON WEST PARK STREET. IT WAS LEARNED DURING THE OFFICER WALK THROUGHS THAT THE VEHICLE WAS STOPPED AT THE LOCATION BY OFFICER C. AGUILAR #9607 AFTER OFFICER W. RODRIGUEZ-GALLARDO #10038 HAD FIRED HIS RIFLE. THE VEHICLE WAS LATER RELOCATED TO 35TH AVENUE TO THE APPROXIMATE LOCATION AT THE TIME OF THE SHOOTING BASED ON REVIEWING THE BODY WORN CAMERA FOOTAGE. THE VEHICLE WAS ALSO PLACED AT THE LOCATION WHERE OFFICER W. RODRIGUEZ-GALLARDO PERCEIVED HE WAS WHEN HE SHOT HIS RIFLE. ONCE THE VEHICLE WAS PHOTOGRAPHED AT THESE LOCATIONS, IT WAS REMOVED FROM THE SCENE TO COMPLETE THE SCENE PROCESSING. PHOTOGRAPHS WERE TAKEN THROUGH THE OPTIC OF OFFICER W. RODRIGUEZ-GALLARDO'S RIFLE AT THE APPROXIMATE LOCATION AND HIS PERCEIVED LOCATION OF SHOOTING HIS RIFLE.

DURING THE WALK THROUGH INTERVIEW WITH OFFICER W. RODRIGUEZ-GALLARDO, HE POINTED OUT THE LOCATION HE PERCEIVED HE WAS WHEN HE FIRED HIS RIFLE WHILE ON 35TH AVENUE. THIS LOCATION WAS MARKED WITH A GREEN COLORED CHIP. A GREEN CHIP WAS PLACED ON PARK STREET NEAR THE AUTOMOBILE GATE WHERE OFFICER W. RODRIGUEZ-GALLARDO PERCEIVED THE SUSPECT TO BE LOCATED WHEN HE FIRED HIS RIFLE AT THE SUSPECT. ONCE THE WALK THROUGH INTERVIEWS WERE COMPLETED, A GREEN COLORED VERSA CONE WERE PLACED OVER THE TWO GREEN CHIPS FOR PHOTOGRAPHS AND SCANNING.

THE BACK DROP OF THE LOCATION OF THE SUSPECT WAS THE STREET AND OPEN COMMON AREAS OF THE SANTOLINA NEIGHBORHOOD. A BLOCK WALL WAS ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF PARK STREET.

A SPENT CASING (ITEM 1) WITH A HEAD STAMP OF "HORNADY 223 REM" WAS LOCATED SOUTH OF PARK STREET NEAR A FIRE HYDRANT ON THE EAST SIDE OF 35TH AVENUE. THIS CASING WAS LOCATED IN CLOSE PROXIMITY WHERE OFFICER W. RODRIGUEZ-GALLARDO INDICATED HE PERCEIVED HE WAS WHEN HE FIRED HIS RIFLE.

A BLACK SPRINGFIELD XD-9 (ITEM 2) 9MM SEMIAUTOMATIC HANDGUN WITH SERIAL NUMBER WAS LOCATED IN THE GRAVEL SOUTH OF THE VEHICLE GATE ON PARK STREET. THE GUN HAD MARKS ON THE REAR OF THE SLIDE CONSISTENT WITH FALLING AND CONTACTING A HARD SURFACE. A CARTRIDGE (ITEM 2A) WITH A HEAD STAMP OF "S&B 9X19 21" WAS INSIDE THE CHAMBER OF THE HANDGUN. A MAGAZINE (ITEM 2B) WAS INSIDE THE MAGAZINE WELL OF THE HANDGUN. THE MAGAZINE APPEARED TO HAVE APPROXIMATELY ELEVEN CARTRIDGES LOADED BASED UPON WHAT WAS VISIBLE THROUGH THE CIRCULAR WINDOWS.

A PORTION OF A RED HOODED SWEAT SHIRT (ITEM 3) REEBOK BRAND SIZE 2XL WAS ON PARK STREET NORTH OF THE HANDGUN. THE PORTION OF THE HOODED SWEATSHIRT HAD A FRONT CENTER POCKET AND THE HOOD. A SET OF SPECTACLES (ITEM 4) WAS WITH THE HOODED PORTION OF SWEATSHIRT. A CUT BLACK TANK TOP (ITEM 5) GEORGE BRAND SIZE 2XL WAS WITH THE SPECTACLES AND RED HOODED SWEATSHIRT.

AN ANDROID CELLPHONE IN A BLUE CASE (ITEM 6) WAS EAST OF THE RED HOODED SWEATSHIRT. THE PHONE COULD NOT BE ACCESSED TO PLACE IT IN AIRPLANE MODE. THE HOME SCREEN OF THE PHONE WAS A SAN FRANCISCO 49RS LOGO. THE PHONE RANG NUMEROUS TIMES THROUGHOUT THE INVESTIGATION.

A RED BOX OF PLAYING CARDS (ITEM 7) WAS NORTH OF THE RED HOODED SWEATSHIRT AND WERE INSIDE A CLEAR PLASTIC BAG CONSISTENT WITH AN OFFICER PROPERTY BAG.

A PORTION OF A RED SWEATSHIRT (ITEM 8) WAS NORTH OF THE RED HOODED SWEATSHIRT. THE PORTION DID NOT HAVE A BRAND AND IT APPEARED IT WAS THE MISSING PORTION OF THE REEBOK BRAND HOODED SWEATSHIRT AND APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN CUT FROM THE OTHER PORTION.

A SWAB OF BLOOD (ITEM 9) WAS OBTAINED FROM A POOL OF BLOOD WEST OF ITEM 3 AND IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO WHERE THE SUSPECT HAD FALLEN TO THE GROUND.

THERE WERE OTHER PATTERNS OF APPARENT BLOOD WITHIN THE SCENE TO INCLUDE SOME SHOE PRINT PATTERNS. THESE WERE NOT SWABBED OR INDIVIDUALLY MARKED FOR EVIDENCE COLLECTION DUE TO THE VIDEO BEING REVIEWED AND SHOWING THE SUSPECT WAS ALONE AND DID NOT MOVE FROM THE LOCATION WHERE HE WAS SHOT. THESE PATTERNS APPEARED TO BE FROM RENDERING AID AND/OR FROM SECURING THE SCENE.



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AFTER ALL EVIDENCE WAS REMOVED, I CONDUCTED AN ADDITIONAL SEARCH OF THE AREA AND CONCLUDED THE SCENE INVESTIGATION AT APPROXIMATELY 1900 HOURS. CLEAN SCENE WAS CONTACTED AND REQUESTED TO RESPONDED TO CLEAN ANY BIOHAZARD MATERIAL FROM THE SCENE.

EVIDENCE IDENTIFICATION:

ITEMS IDENTIFIED OF INTEREST RELEVANT TO THE INVESTIGATION, WERE PHOTOGRAPHED IN THEIR ORIGINAL POSITION OR FOUND LOCATION, ASSIGNED THE APPROPRIATE EVIDENCE PLACARD, OR STICKER AND THEN PHOTOGRAPHED AGAIN WITH THE IDENTIFYING PLACARD / STICKER.

EVIDENCE COLLECTED FROM THE SCENE, WERE IDENTIFIED WITH NUMBERED PLACARDS, ITEMS NOT COLLECTED FROM THE SCENE HOWEVER IDENTIFIED AS EVIDENCE OR ITEMS OF VALUE TO THE INVESTIGATION, WERE ASSIGNED A LETTERED PLACARD OR STICKER.

THE PHOENIX POLICE STANDARD EVIDENCE PLACARDS WERE YELLOW IN COLOR, AND CONTAIN A LARGE BLACK NUMBER OR LETTER STAMPED INTO THE PLASTIC. EACH PLACARD HAD A FIVE-CENTIMETER MEASUREMENT WITH A SCALE DISPLAY, WHICH WAS IMPRINTED ON THREE LOCATIONS OF THE PLACARD.

THE EVIDENCE PLACARD WAS TENT SHAPED, WITH ONE PORTION OF THE FLAT BOTTOM SURFACE EXTENDED TO ALLOW PLACEMENT NEXT TO THE ITEM OF INTEREST, WHICH PROVIDED CONTRAST AND SCALE.

EACH PLACARD WAS POSITIONED IN A MANNER TO DISPLAY A NORTH ORIENTATION (OR UP POSITION) WHEN POSSIBLE. DUE TO SURFACE DESIGN OR SHAPE OR THE PARTICULAR ITEM OF EVIDENCE DISPLAYED, A NORTH ORIENTATION MAY NOT ALWAYS HAVE BEEN POSSIBLE.

AFTER PHOTOGRAPHING THE ITEM WITHOUT A PLACARD, THE APPROPRIATE PLACARD WAS PLACED BESIDE THE ITEM AS DESCRIBED ABOVE, THEN PHOTOGRAPHED AGAIN. ONLY THE ONE NUMBER OR LETTER IS ASSIGNED TO EACH ITEM, UNLESS DEPICTING TRAJECTORY OR FURTHER DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE SAME ITEM.

EACH ITEM OF EVIDENCE WAS REPEATED IN THE SAME MANNER, THEN EVENTUALLY COLLECTED AND IMPOUNDED Public Narrative

ON JANUARY 17, 2025, AT APPROXIMATELY 1112 HOURS OFFICER CHAVEZ 11521 AND I RESPONDED TO THE AREA OF WEST PARK STREET AND SOUTH 35TH AVENUE REGARDING AN OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING. WE HEARD THE PHOENIX POLICE DEPARTMENT ALL CALL TONE FOR AN OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING AND IT ADVISED US THAT THE SHOOTING OCCURRED IN THE AREA SOUTH 35TH AVENUE AND WEST BASELINE ROAD.

UPON OUR ARRIVAL WE JOINED THE ARREST TEAM TO MOVE UP AND ASSESS THE DOWN SUSPECT. IT WAS STATED THAT THE GUN WAS NEXT TO THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE SUSPECT WHICH WOULD BE THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST PARK STREET, I OBSERVED THE GUN LOCATED NEXT TO THE COMMUNITY ENTRANCE NEXT TO A BUSH. OFFICER CHAVEZ MOVED TO PRESERVE THE GUN WHILE OTHER OFFICERS MOVED TO ASSESS THE DOWN SUSPECT.

I OBSERVED A HISPANIC MALE WITH BLUE JEANS AND RED SHIRT SWEAT ON WITH A GUN SHOT WOUND TO THE RIGHT LOWER PORTION OF HIS BACK. I PLACED HANDCUFFS ON HIM TO THE REAR OF HIS BACK. AT THIS POINT TO FURTHER ASSESS THE SUSPECT, I RETRIEVED MEDICAL SHEARS FROM MY PHOENIX POLICE TAHOE AND CUT THE FRONT AND BACK OF THE SUSPECTS SWEATSHIRT AND HIS BLACK TANK TOP UNDER THIS SWEATSHIRT. OFFICER GASTELUM 11774, OFFICER CHAVEZ 11521, AND I PLACED THE MALE ON THIS LEFT SIDE INTO THE RECOVERY POSITION. AT APPROXIMATELY 1125 HOURS PHOENIX FIRE DEPARTMENT BEGAN THE TRANSPORT TO GOOD SAMRIATAN HOSPITAL. WE ARRIVED AT THE HOSPITAL AT APPROXIMATELY 1145 HOURS WE ARRIVED AT THE EMERGENCY ROOM AT GOOD SAMRIATAN HOSPITAL.

THE FOLLOWING IS A SUMMARY OF THE INTERVIEW AND IS NOT A VERBATIM TRANSCRIPT. REFER TO THE DIGITALLY RECORDED INTERVIEW FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.

NARRATIVE:

ON JANUARY 17, 2025, AT APPROXIMATELY 1428 HOURS, I INTERVIEWED OFFICER W. RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO #10038 REFERENCE HIS OBSERVATIONS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS INCIDENT THAT INCLUDED AN OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING. THE INTERVIEW WAS CONDUCTED ON SCENE AT 7300 SOUTH 35TH AVENUE. PRESENT DURING THE WALK-THROUGH INTERVIEW WERE DETECTIVES THOMPSON #10150 AND HOVLAND #8192, AGENTS J. PERKINSON #11599 AND B. YOUNG #11590 FROM THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, CRIME SCENE SPECIALISTS SIMPSON #A5810 AND LUCAS #A5471, DEPUTY COUNTY ATTORNEY TOM VAN DORN, AND ATTORNEY ALAN KUFFNER (REPRESENTING OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO).

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO WAS A COMMUNITY ACTION OFFICER FOR THE MARYVALE-ESTRELLA PRECINCT. APPROXIMATELY ONE MONTH PRIOR, HE RECEIVED A COMPLAINT ABOUT DRUGS BEING SOLD AT A HOUSE AT PREVIOUSLY, OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO FOUND NOTHING AT THE HOUSE AND IT APPEARED ABANDONED. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO'S SERGEANT ASKED HIM TO CHECK OUT THE DONNER HOUSE AGAIN ON JANUARY 17TH AS HE RECEIVED A NEW COMPLAINT FOR THE SAME HOUSE AND FOR THE SAME CRIMINAL ACTIVITY. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO READ THE EMAIL ALOUD FROM HIS SERGEANT TO HIM FOR US TO HEAR.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO AND OFFICER AGUILAR WENT TO THE HOUSE AND KNOCKED ON THE DOOR.



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OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO COULD SEE INSIDE THE FRONT WINDOW AND THE HOUSE AGAIN APPEARED ABANDONED. THROUGH THE WINDOW, OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO OBSERVED MULTIPLE SUBJECTS RUN OUT THE OPEN BACK DOOR INTO THE BACKYARD AND THEN JUMP OVER THE BACK FENCE. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO HAD NO VICTIM AT THAT TIME AND WENT AND MADE SOME PHONE CALLS TO TRY TO FIND A VICTIM OR OTHER CONTACT.

THE TWO OFFICERS DECIDED TO LOOK FOR AND CONTACT SOME OF THE SUBJECTS THAT FLED FROM THE HOUSE. THEY DROVE TO 31ST AVENUE AND BASELINE AND OBSERVED MALE SUBJECT STILL BEHIND THE WALL OF THE HOUSE. THEY CONDUCTED A SUBJECT STOP WITH THE INDIVIDUAL AND OBTAINED HIS INFORMATION FOR A FIELD INTERROGATION. THAT MALE WAS RELEASED AND OFFICER AGUILAR POINTED OUT ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL NEARBY HE WAS WATCHING WHILE OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO CONTACTED THE FIRST SUBJECT.

THE TWO OFFICERS DROVE WESTBOUND ON BASELINE AND OBSERVED THE MALE SUBJECT OFFICER AGUILAR WAS WATCHING TRYING TO HIDE FROM THEM ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF BASELINE. THE OFFICERS MADE A U-TURN AND PULLED UP ALONGSIDE THE MALE WEARING A RED JACKET. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO VERBALLY IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS A PHOENIX POLICE OFFICER AND TOLD THE SUBJECT TO STOP, ADDING HE WANTED TO TALK WITH HIM.

THE MALE SUBJECT IGNORED OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO, TURNED AROUND, AND RAN WESTBOUND ALONG BASELINE. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO OBSERVED OFFICER AGUILAR BEGIN TO PURSUE THE MALE SUBJECT ON FOOT. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO THEN OBSERVED THE MALE SUBJECT PULL A HANDGUN FROM HIS JACKET AND POINT IT UP AS HE CONTINUED RUNNING.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO CONTINUED RUNNING AFTER THE SUBJECT AND OFFICER AGUILAR GOT BACK INTO THE TAHOE TO FOLLOW THE SUBJECT AS HE CROSSED TO THE NORTH SIDE OF BASELINE ROAD. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO MET UP AND OFFICER AGUILAR, RETRIEVED HIS PATROL RIFLE FROM THE BACK OF THE TAHOE, AND GOT IN THE PASSENGER SEAT.

WHEN THEY REACHED 35TH AVENUE, THE SUBJECT TURNED NORTH. WHEN THE OFFICERS PASSED BY THE BUS STOP ON 35TH AVENUE A CITIZEN YELLED TO THEM, "HEY, THAT GUY HAS A GUN". OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO CONTINUED TO OBSERVE THE MALE SUBJECT RUNNING NORTHBOUND ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE ROAD, PARALLEL AND NEXT TO THE COMMUNITY FENCE LINE.

WHEN THE MALE SUBJECT REACHED PARK STREET, HE CAME UPON THE ENTRY GATE TO THE GATED HOUSING COMMUNITY. THE MALE SUBJECT CUT ACROSS THE SOUTHEAST CORNER AND CONTINUED RUNNING TOWARD THE OPEN GATE. AS THE MALE SUBJECT APPROACHED THE GATE, HE TURNED HIS UPPER BODY TO THE RIGHT AND LOOKED BACK TOWARDS THE OFFICERS IN THE TAHOE. AS HE DID SO, THE MALE POINTED THE HANDGUN TOWARD THE OFFICERS.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO RESPONDED TO THE SUBJECT POINTING THE HANDGUN AT THEM BY FIRING ONCE AT THE MALE SUBJECT WITH HIS PATROL RIFLE. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO ESTIMATED THE LOCATION WHERE HE FIRED BASED ON A FIRE HYDRANT NEAR THE SIDE OF THE ROAD, SOUTH OF PARK STREET. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO PLACED A GREEN CHIP ON THE ASPHALT IN THE AREA WHERE HE ESTIMATED HE FIRED FROM.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO EXPLAINED HE WAS PARTIALLY SEATED IN THE PASSENGER SEAT OF THE TAHOE. HE WAS TURNED TO THE RIGHT AND HAD ONE FOOT ON THE RUNNING BOARD AND THE OTHER ON THE GROUND.

AFTER OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO FIRED, THE MALE SUBJECT FELL TO THE GROUND. THE OFFICERS MOVED THEIR TAHOE FORWARD AND TURNED ONTO PARK STREET SO THEY WERE CLOSER TO THE MALE. THE TWO OFFICERS HELD AT THE TAHOE UNTIL OTHER OFFICERS ARRIVED ON SCENE AND AN ARREST TEAM WAS PUT TOGETHER TO APPROACH AND DETAIN THE MALE. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO WAS PART OF THE ARREST TEAM AND WALKED UP BEHIND A SHIELD TO THE MALE SUBJECT LYING ON THE GROUND. AS THEY APPROACHED THE MALE, OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO OBSERVED A BLACK HANDGUN ON THE GROUND NEAR A BUSH NOT FAR FROM THE MALE.



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OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO DIRECTED DETECTIVE THOMPSON TO PLACE A SECOND GREEN CHIP ON THE GROUND WHERE HE ESTIMATED THE MALE SUBJECT WAS WHEN HE FIRED AT HIM.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO VERIFIED THE FIRST TIME HE OBSERVED THE MALE SUBJECT IN THE RED JACKET WAS WHEN OFFICER AGUILAR POINTED HIM OUT TO HIM ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF BASELINE AS THEY WERE APPROACHING HIM.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO SAID THEY USED THEIR VEHICLE LIGHTS AND SIREN AS THEY APPROACHED THE MALE SUBJECT TO CLEAR TRAFFIC. THE MALE LOOKED DIRECTLY AT OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO WHEN HE IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AND COMMANDED HIM TO STOP. THE MALE DID NOT SAY ANYTHING, BUT OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO WAS SURE THE MALE KNEW THEY WERE POLICE OFFICERS WHEN HE FLED FROM THEM. THE MALE WAS ALSO WATCHING THEM AS THEY PULLED UP TO HIM.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO DID NOT OBSERVE THE MALE POINT THE HANDGUN AT ANYONE ELSE WHILE HE RAN FROM THEM ON BASELINE ROAD AND ON 35TH AVENUE.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO ESTIMATED THE MALE SUBJECT WAS SEVERAL FEET WEST OF THE GREEN CHIP HE DIRECTED DETECTIVE THOMPSON TO PLACE WHEN HE POINTED THE HANDGUN AT HIM AND OFFICER AGUILAR.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO VERIFIED NO ONE MOVED THE HANDGUN FROM ITS LOCATION IN THE LANDSCAPING. IT WAS STILL WHERE HE OBSERVED IT WHEN THEY APPROACHED THE MALE TO HANDCUFF HIM.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO WORE A CLASS C PHOENIX POLICE UNIFORM WITH SHORT SLEEVE SHIRT WITH PHOENIX POLICE PATCHES ON BOTH SHOULDERS AND A METAL POLICE BADGE ON HIS CHEST. HE WORE HIS GUN BELT WITH HANDGUN, TASER, RADIO, MAGAZINES, AND HANDCUFFS. HIS BODY CAMERA MOUNT WAS AFFIXED TO THE FRONT OF HIS SHIRT ON HIS MID CHEST. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO ACTIVATED THE BODY CAMERA WHEN THEY APPROACHED THE MALE SUBJECT ON BASELINE.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO CARRIED HIS PERSONAL GLOCK 17C THAT WAS NOT FIRED DURING THIS INCIDENT. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO FIRED ONCE FROM HIS CITY ISSUED DDM4 .223 WITH A TRIJICON MRO RED DOT OPTIC. HE CARRIED A SPARE MAGAZINE IN HIS POCKET DURING THE INCIDENT. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO ESTIMATED HE WAS THIRTY-FIVE YARDS FROM THE SUBJECT WHEN FIRED AT HIM.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO STATED HE FIRED AT THE MALE SUBJECT BECAUSE WHEN THE MALE SUBJECT POINTED THE HANDGUN AT HIM HE "FEARED FOR MY SAFETY" AND FEARED THE MALE MAY SHOOT HIS PARTNER OFFICER AGUILAR. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO SAID HE OBSERVED OFFICER AGUILAR "CRINGE" AND APPEAR TO SLIGHTLY DUCK WHEN THE HANDGUN WAS POINTED IN THEIR DIRECTION.

AFTER SHOOTING THE MALE SUBJECT, OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO ASKED OFFICER AGUILAR IF HE WAS OK, OR IF HE HAD BEEN SHOT. OFFICER AGUILAR RESPONDED HE WAS FINE AND THEN OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO BROADCAST THE "998" ON THE RADIO.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO BELIEVED THERE WAS A VEHICLE NEAR THE GATES WHEN THE SHOOTING OCCURRED BUT HE COULD NOT DESCRIBE IT, NOR ITS LOCATION. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO VERIFIED HE WAS FAMILIAR WITH THE GATED COMMUNITY WHERE THE SHOOTING OCCURRED AND THAT IT WAS COMMON FOR RESIDENTS OF THE COMMUNITY TO BE WALKING OUTSIDE AT ALL TIMES OF THE DAY. KNOWING THIS CONCERNED HIM IF THE MALE SUBJECT WERE TO GAIN ACCESS TO THE GATED COMMUNITY OF RESIDENTIAL HOUSES.

OTHER PATROL OFFICERS ON SCENE PROVIDED FIRST AID TO THE MALE SUBJECT AFTER THE SHOOTING, INCLUDING CPR.

THE INTERVIEW CONCLUDED AT 1452 HOURS.

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AT APPROXIMATELY 1108 HOURS I ATTACHED MYSELF TO THE CALL WHERE 803X, OFFICERS WILLIAM RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO #10038 AND OFFICER CHRISTIAN AGUILAR #9607 WERE ADVISING OF A SUBJECT RUNNING FROM THEM. THE SUBJECT WAS DESCRIBED AS A HISPANIC MALE WITH A RED SWEATER, BLUE JEANS AND WAS ARMED WITH A HANDGUN. THE HISPANIC MALE WAS RUNNING ON BASELINE IN THE AREA OF 35TH AVENUE. A SHORT TIME LATER 803X ADVISED THEY WERE INVOLVED IN A 998. 803X ADVISED THEY WERE ON 35TH AVENUE JUST NORTH OF BASELINE ROAD ON PARK STREET. I ARRIVED AT APPROXIMATELY 1112 HOURS. I PARKED MY TAHOE JUST NORTH AND FACING WESTBOUND TO 803X'S TAHOE WHICH WAS ALSO FACING WESTBOUND ON PARK STREET.

Administrative Info

WHEN I ARRIVED AND EXITED MY VEHICLE, I SAW OFFICER AGUILAR ON THE DRIVERS SIDE WITH HIS HANDGUN DRAWN AND OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO ON THE PASSENGER SIDE WITH A RIFLE DRAWN. TO OUR WEST WAS A HISPANIC MALE WITH A RED SWEATER AND BLUE JEANS ON. THE HISPANIC MALE WAS LAYING ON THE GROUND FACING AWAY FROM US. OFFICER AGUILAR, OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO AND I WENT TO THE REAR OF THE TAHOE ON THE PASSENGER SIDE TO MAINTAIN COVER. OFFICER AGUILAR HAD A LESS LETHAL WEAPON WHICH HE DREW FROM THE REAR OF THE TAHOE. I TOOK OVER AS THE POINT OFFICER WITH MY GUN DRAWN ON THE HISPANIC MALE WHILE OFFICER AGUILAR GRABBED HIS LESS LETHAL. ADDITIONAL UNITS ARRIVED QUICKLY AND ONE WAS A K-9 HANDLER WITH A SHIELD. A FEW 400 OFFICERS ARRIVED AND JOINED OUR STACK TO SERVE AS THE ARREST TEAM.

OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO WAS THE LEAD OFFICER BEHIND THE SHIELD WITH HIS RIFLE WHILE OFFICER AGUILAR WAS SECOND WITH HIS LESS LETHAL. I WAS THIRD AND THE OFFICER BEHIND ME WERE SET TO GO HANDS ON. THE FIFTH OFFICER WAS SET TO LOCATE AND SECURE THE WEAPON.

AS WE MADE OUR APPROACH, I COULD SEE A CELL PHONE JUST TO THE WEST OF THE HISPANIC MALE AND A BLACK HANDGUN JUST TO THE SOUTH NEAR A WALL AND BUSHES. THE HISPANIC MALE WAS PLACED IN HANDCUFFS WITH HIS HANDS TO HIS BACK. WE CONDUCTED A PAT DOWN AND SEARCH FOR ANY OTHER WEAPONS.

RADIO WAS ADVISED THE HISPANIC MALE WAS IN CUSTODY. SCISSORS WERE USED TO CUT AWAY THE TOP LAYERS OF CLOTHING TO IDENTIFY WOUNDS. I SAW A SINGLE WOUND LOCATED ON THE REAR RIGHT SIDE ABOVE THE HIP AREA. OFFICERS WERE CHECKING FOR A PULSE WHICH WAS FOUND. THERE APPEARED TO BE NO OTHER BLEEDING THAT I COULD SEE. THE HANDCUFFS WERE MOVED TO THE FRONT. OFFICERS BEGAN CHEST COMPRESSIONS JUST AS FIRE ARRIVED. FIRE TOOK OVER THE CHEST COMPRESSIONS AND TRANSPORTED FOR ADDITIONAL CARE.

I STOOD BY THE SCENE AND COMPLETED MY SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT PRIOR TO LEAVING. THIS ENDED MY INVOLVEMENT WITH THIS INCIDENT.

THE RECORDING WAS LATER UPLOADED TO EVIDENCE.COM FOR PRESERVATION. THE FOLLOWING IS A SUMMARY OF THE INTERVIEW. REFER TO UPLOADED RECORDING FOR THE INTERVIEW IN ITS ENTIRETY.

DAVID APPROACHED OFFICERS SWARTZ #9371 AND FLESHER #11101, WHO WERE CONDUCTING SCENE SECURITY AT THE 35TH AVENUE AND BASELINE ROAD. DAVID INDICATE TO THE OFFICERS HE SAW THE SUSPECT WITH A GUN IN HIS HAND RUNNING NORTH ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF 35TH AVENUE FROM BASELINE ROAD. THAT INFORMATION WAS RELAYED TO SERGEANT MURPHY, WHO THEN DIRECTED ME TO INTERVIEW DAVID.

I WALKED TO THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SCENE AND CONTACTED OFFICER FLESHER WHO PROVIDED ME WITH DAVID'S BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION. HE ESCORTED DAVID TO THE BUS STOP WHERE I SPOKE WITH DAVID ABOUT WHAT HE SAW.

DAVID WAS SEATED AT THE BUS STOP WHEN HE SAW A SUBJECT HE RECOGNIZED AS "NINER" RUNNING NORTH ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF 35TH AVENUE FROM BASELINE ROAD IN THE LANDSCAPE ROCK AREA. HE DESCRIBED "NINER" AS A STOCKY, HEAVIER SET WHITE MALE WITH TANNED SKIN AND SHOULDER LENGTH HAIR. HE WAS WEARING NO SHIRT AND HAD A BLACK SEMI-AUTOMATIC GUN IN HIS RIGHT HAND. HE CONTINUED RUNNING NORTHBOUND AND THEN OUT OF SIGHT AS HE TURNED EASTBOUND INTO THE HOUSING COMMUNITY JUST NORTH (AT PARK STREET). DAVID DID NOT HEAR THE SHOOTING. HE DID NOT KNOW WHAT HAPPENED PRIOR TO SEEING "NINER". HE DID NOT SEE ANYONE CHASING AFTER "NINER" AND "NINER" WAS RUNNING ALONE.

DAVID KNEW "NINER" FROM SEEING HIM A FEW TIMES OVER THE PAST SIX MONTHS WHILE HANGING OUT AT CHAVEZ PARK SOUTHWEST OF THE 35TH AVENUE AND BASELINE ROAD INTERSECTION.

NARRATIVE:

ON JANUARY 17, 2025, AT APPROXIMATELY 1502 HOURS, I CONDUCTED A WALK-THROUGH INTERVIEW WITH WITH PATROL OFFICER C. AGUILAR #9607 REFERENCE HIS OBSERVATIONS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS INCIDENT THAT INCLUDED AN OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING. THE INTERVIEW WAS CONDUCTED ON SCENE AT 7300 SOUTH 35TH AVENUE. PRESENT DURING THE INTERVIEW WERE DETECTIVES THOMPSON #10150 AND HOVLAND #8192, AGENTS J. PERKINSON #11599 AND B. YOUNG #11590 FROM THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, AND CRIME SCENE SPECIALISTS SIMPSON #A5810 AND LUCAS #A5471.

OFFICER AGUILAR WAS ON A TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT WITH THE COMMUNITY ACTION OFFICERS FROM THE MARYVALE-ESTRELLA PRECINCT. HE HAD BEEN RIDING WITH OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO DURING THE WEEK. OFFICER AGUILAR WENT WITH OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO TO CHECK ON A HOUSE AT REFERENCE A DRUG COMPLAINT.

THE TWO OFFICERS RESPONDED TO THE HOUSE AND KNOCKED ON THE DOOR. OFFICER AGUILAR COULD HEAR UNKNOWN NOISES INSIDE THE HOUSE. OFFICER AGUILAR STEPPED TO THE EAST SIDE OF THE HOUSE SO HE COULD LOOK OVER THE BACK FENCE INTO THE BACKYARD TO WATCH FOR ANYONE. WHILE STANDING THERE, OFFICER AGUILAR OBSERVED TWO MALES JUMP OVER THE BACK FENCE. ONE WORE A WHITE T-SHIRT AND AND THE OTHER A RED SWEATER.



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OFFICER AGUILAR TOLD OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO ABOUT THE SUBJECTS HE OBSERVED JUMP THE WALL. THE OFFICERS DECIDED TO GO TO BASELINE ROAD AND ATTEMPT TO CONTACT THE TWO MALES OFFICER AGUILAR OBSERVED JUMP THE WALL. THEY OBSERVED THE MALE WITH THE WHITE T-SHIRT NEAR THE SAME WALL HE JUMPED OVER. THE OFFICERS CONTACTED AND IDENTIFIED THE MALE. OFFICER AGUILAR CONTINUED TO LOOK FOR AND OBSERVED THE MALE IN THE RED SWEATER RUNNING WESTBOUND ON BASELINE ROAD AND THEN CROSS TO THE SOUTH SIDE OF BASELINE ROAD.

THE OFFICERS DECIDED TO SEARCH FOR AND CONTACT THE MALE WITH THE RED SWEATER. THEY SEARCHED THE AREA OF 32ND AVENUE AND DID NOT SEE HIM. WHEN THEY RETURNED TO BASELINE ROAD, THEY OBSERVED THE MALE IN THE RED SWEATER STANDING AGAINST A RED WALL ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE BASELINE.

OFFICER AGUILAR MADE A U-TURN AND PULLED ALONGSIDE THE MALE IN THE RED SWEATER. THEY GAVE THE MALE VERBAL COMMANDS TO STOP AND THE MALE TURNED AROUND AND RAN AWAY FROM THEM WESTBOUND ON BASELINE. OFFICER AGUILAR BEGAN TO CHASE THE MALE ON FOOT AND CLOSED TO WITHIN EIGHT FEET. AT THAT TIME, HE OBSERVED THE MALE "DIGGING" IN HIS FRONT WAISTBAND AND OFFICER AGUILAR STOPPED RUNNING AFTER THE MALE SUBJECT EXPECTING HIM TO PULL OUT A WEAPON. THE MALE PULLED OUT A BLACK HANDGUN AND HELD IT AT HIS SIDE AND CONTINUED RUNNING WESTBOUND AWAY FROM THE OFFICERS.

OFFICER AGUILAR OBSERVED THE MALE CROSS THE ROAD TO THE NORTH SIDE OF BASELINE AND CONTINUE WESTBOUND. THEY FOLLOWED THE MALE IN THEIR TAHOE TO WHERE HE TURNED NORTH ONTO 35TH AVENUE. OFFICER AGUILAR OBSERVED THE MALE ATTEMPT TO JUMP A METAL FENCE INTO A RESIDENTIAL YARD WITH THE HANDGUN STILL IN HIS RIGHT HAND. HE WAS UNABLE TO CLIMB OVER THE FENCE AND DROPPED BACK DOWN.

THE OFFICERS FOLLOWED THE MALE SUBJECT AS HE RAN NORTHBOUND ALONG THE WALL ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE ROAD. WHEN THE MALE SUBJECT REACHED PARK STREET, HE TURNED EAST AND RAN THROUGH A SMALL FENCE OPENING. AS HE DID SO, THE MALE SUBJECT TURNED TO HIS RIGHT AND TOWARD THE TWO OFFICERS IN THE TAHOE AND POINTED THE HANDGUN AT THEM. OFFICER AGUILAR ESTIMATED THE MALE HAD THE HANDGUN POINTED AT THEM FOR APPROXIMATELY 2 SECONDS.

OFFICER AGUILAR SAID HE "CRINKLED" AND VISIBLY SHOWED US HOW HE TRIED TO LOWER HIMSELF IN HIS SEAT TO AVOID BEING SHOT. OFFICER AGUILAR FEARED THE MALE SUBJECT WAS GOING TO SHOOT AT THEM AND WANTED TO GET BELOW THE DASHBOARD FOR COVER. OFFICER AGUILAR STOPPED THE TAHOE AND OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GALLARDO HAD THE PASSENGER DOOR PARTIALLY OPEN AND FIRED ONCE AT THE MALE SUBJECT WITH HIS PATROL RIFLE.

THE MALE SUBJECT IMMEDIATELY FELL TO THE GROUND AND OFFICER AGUILAR OBSERVED HE CONTINUED "DIGGING AROUND". OFFICER AGUILAR TURNED ONTO PARK STREET EAST OF 35TH AVENUE AND STOPPED THE TAHOE. OFFICER AGUILAR THEN OBSERVED THE MALE SUBJECT TOSS AN UNKNOWN ITEM AWAY FROM HIM.

THE TWO OFFICERS REMAINED AT THE TAHOE UNTIL MORE PATROL OFFICERS ARRIVED ON SCENE. THEY FORMED AN ARREST TEAM AND OFFICER AGUILAR SWITCHED FROM HIS HANDGUN TO THE 40MM LAUNCHER. THE ARREST TEAM APPROACHED THE MALE SUBJECT AND HANDCUFFED HIM. OFFICER AGUILAR OBSERVED THE HANDGUN AND A CELL PHONE NEAR THE MALE SUBJECT AS THEY APPROACHED. THE OTHER RESPONDING OFFICER PERFORMED CPR ON THE MALE SUBJECT.

OFFICER AGUILAR VERIFIED THE MALE SUBJECT WAS LOOKING AT THEM WHEN THEY PULLED UP TO HIM AND GAVE HIM VERBAL COMMANDS TO STOP. OFFICER AGUILAR BELIEVED THE MALE SUBJECT KNEW THEY WERE POLICE OFFICERS.

OFFICER AGUILAR DESCRIBED THE APPROXIMATE LOCATION THE MALE SUBJECT WAS WHEN HE TURNED AND POINTED THE HANDGUN AT THEM. THE MALE HAD CUT ACROSS THE THE SOUTHEAST CORNER AND WAS RUNNING BETWEEN THE OPENING IN THE BROWN FENCING TOWARD THE OPEN GATE OF THE RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITY.

OFFICER AGUILAR HAD HIS BODY WORN CAMERA ACTIVATED PRIOR TO ATTEMPTING TO STOP THE MALE IN THE RED SWEATER.



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OFFICER AGUILAR WORE A CLASS B PHOENIX POLICE UNIFORM WITH AN OUTER VEST CARRIER. THE SHIRT HAD PHOENIX POLICE PATCHES ON BOTH SHOULDERS AND A METAL POLICE BADGE ON HIS CHEST. HE WORE A GUN BELT WITH 40MM ROUNDS, HIS HANDGUN (CITY OWNED GLOCK 17), TASER, MAGAZINES, FLASHLIGHT, AND HANDCUFFS.

OFFICER AGUILAR DID NOT FIRE HIS WEAPON, NOR HIS 40MM LAUNCHER DURING THE INCIDENT.

THE INTERVIEW CONCLUDED AT 1525 HOURS.

RESPONSE/HOSPITAL FOLLOW UP

ON JANUARY 17, 2025 AT APPROXIMATELY 1230 HOURS, SERGEANT MURPHY #9213 CONTACTED ME IN PERSON, AT POLICE HEADQUARTERS. HE REQUESTED I RESPONDED TO BANNER UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL, 1111 E MCDOWELL ROAD, PHOENIX, ARIZONA FOR THIS INVESTIGATION. I CONTACTED THE MARICOPA MEDICAL EXAMINER'S OFFICE WHILE DRIVING TO THE HOSPITAL, AT APPROXIMATELY 1245 HOURS. I ARRIVED AT THE HOSPITAL AT APPROXIMATELY 1247 HOURS.

WHEN I ARRIVED, I SPOKE TO OFFICERS BULLIS #11515 AND OFFICER CHAVEZ #11521 WHO WERE STANDING BY WITH THE DECEASED IN THE TRAUMA BAY. THE HOSPITAL STAFF HAD MADE THE DECISION TO HAVE THE DECEASED TRANSPORTED TO THE MORGUE. SECURITY GUARD TONY ROYBAL AND HOSPITAL STAFF TRANSPORTED THE DECEASED TO THE MORGUE. OFFICER BULLIS, CHAVEZ AND I WALKED WITH THE DECEASED TO THE MORGUE. WE ARRIVED AT THE MORGUE AT APPROXIMATELY 1310 HOURS.

WITH ME WAS CRIME SCENE SPECIALIST FINLAY #A3835. ONCE WE WERE IN THE MORGUE, SHE PHOTOGRAPHED THE DECEASED. I NOTED SIGNS OF MEDICAL INTERVENTION SUCH AS INTUBATION, CHEST TUBES AND AN IO IN THE FRONT OF THE DECEASED'S LEFT LEG. I ALSO SAW THE DECEASED HAD A POSSIBLE GUNSHOT WOUND IN HIS LOWER RIGHT BACK. THERE WAS ALSO A DEFECT/BRUISE ON THE CENTER FRONT ABDOMEN AREA, BUT NO EXIT LOCATION OF THE BULLET WAS NOTED. THE BODY BAG THE DECEASED WAS IN DISPLAYED A TAG, WHICH INDICATED HIS MEDICAL RECORDS NUMBER WAS

WHILE AT THE HOSPITAL, OFFICER BULLIS INFORMED ME CPR HAD BEEN CONDUCTED ON THE DECEASED, PRIOR TO THE ARRIVAL OF PHOENIX FIRE. WE REQUESTED SERGEANT SPROSS #5955 RESPOND TO THE HOSPITAL/MORGUE, FOR A DIGITAL FINGERPRINT SCAN OF THE DECEASED. THE DECEASED WAS POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED VIA HIS FINGERPRINTS AS CHRISTOPHER ALAN PHILLIPS, DATE OF BIRTH [1979].

WITH PHILLIPS WAS A CLEAR PLASTIC BAG CONTAINING HIS CLOTHING/PROPERTY. CSS FINLAY PHOTOGRAPHED, AND TOOK CUSTODY OF THE CLOTHING FOR LATER IMPOUNDING. THE CLOTHING CONSISTED OF SOCKS, SHOES, JEANS, BELT AND UNDERWEAR. A SHIRT WAS NOT LOCATED IN THE CLOTHING BAG.

I WAS INFORMED THE OFFICERS INVOLVED IN THE CRITICAL INCIDENT WERE 803X (OFFICER AGUILAR 9607 AND GALLARDO 10038). I ASKBED OFFICER GALLARDO THE PUBLIC SAFETY QUESTIONS AND WAS INFORMED THAT THEY WERE DOING A FOLLOW UP FROM A COMPLAINT THEY HAD AND ONE OF THE SUBJECTS TOOK OFF RUNNING. I WALKED UP AND OBSERVED OFFICER BULLIS 11515 AND CHAVEZ 11521 PROVIDING MEDICAL AID TO THE SUSPECT. THEY ADVISED THEY HAD JUST LOST PULSE SO I ADVISED THEM TO START DOING CPR UNTIL FIRE ARRIVED. I COULD SEE A HANDGUN JUST TO THE SIDE OF WHERE THE SUSPECT WAS SO I ADVISED OFFICER LOPEZ 11887 TO STAND BY THE FIREARM AND NOT TO LEAVE OR ALLOW ANYONE TO TOUCH IT.

SERGEANT BACKUS RESPONDED AND I REQUESTED HE START GETTING PREPARED FOR THE BRIEFING.

FOR THE REST OF THIS CALL I STOOD BY WITH OFFICER GALLARDO UNTIL RELIEVED BY HOMICIDE DETECTIVES. THE ONLY INDIVIDUALS HE HAD CONTACT WITH IN PRIVATE WERE THE APPROPRIATE INDIVIDUALS PER POLICY.
